#### Parent Governor Vacancy

We wish to inform you that there is currently a vacancy for the role of Parent/Carer Governor on our School Governing Body. This is an elected role, and we are currently seeking candidates interested in taking up this position. The term of office for parent governors is four years. To become an elected Parent/Carer Governor, you must have a child who is registered at the school at the time you become a governor. There are of course checks on those eligible to serve and these are detailed in the pack issued to candidates.

Anyone who wishes to serve as a Parent/Carer Governor should be nominated and seconded by Parents/Carers of registered pupils. If there are several nominations, then a secret ballot of Parents/Carers is held to elect the preferred candidate.

Working as a school governor can be hugely rewarding. However, due to the many changes to school governance in recent years, the role of Governor has become a significant and demanding commitment and you will benefit from more information before deciding to take part.
